


MOULDINGS ONE



Federal crown molding shapes adhere to the same style as base moldings: serpentine shapes like the cyma recta and cyma reversa.

Federal Baseboard Moulding

5456 [5/8 x 1-3/4] S4S [3/4 x 7-1/4]

Federal style baseboards feature ogee profiles that rely on the cyma recta and other serpentine shapes. Less ornate shapes are also present in Federal homes. Moldings were commonly painted white – particularly baseboard and crown – were painted white.



1513 [1 x 3]


While Federal style door and window trim could include simple designs, like rectangular planed surfaces, they were often more ornate. These moldings featured reeded and fluted surfaces combined with a cyma recta or other serpentine curve in their profile.
