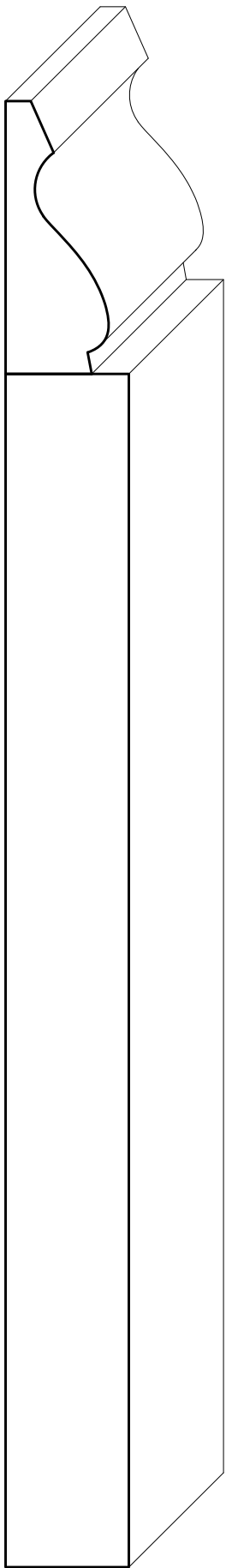

Greek Revival Crown Moulding

3240 [1-1/8 x 3-1/2]

Relatively plain when compared against other neoclassical crown millwork, Greek Revival crown molding profiles rely on the echinus or ovolo to create a proportional balance with base molding profiles.

Greek Revival Baseboard Moulding

5216 [5/8 x 1-5/8]

S4S [3/4 x 7-1/4]

Greek Revival base moldings feature simple cyma recta curves that complement the flowing curvature of other millwork, like casing and crown molding.

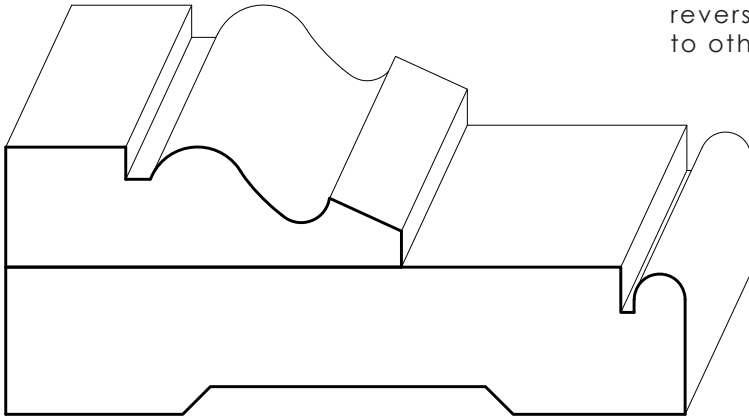

5499 [5/8 x 2-1/16]

1062 [3/4 x 3-1/2]

Doors and windows in Greek Revival homes can be embellished with casing that features the cyma reversa shape with bead and quirk details. Compared to other styles it is relatively unadorned.

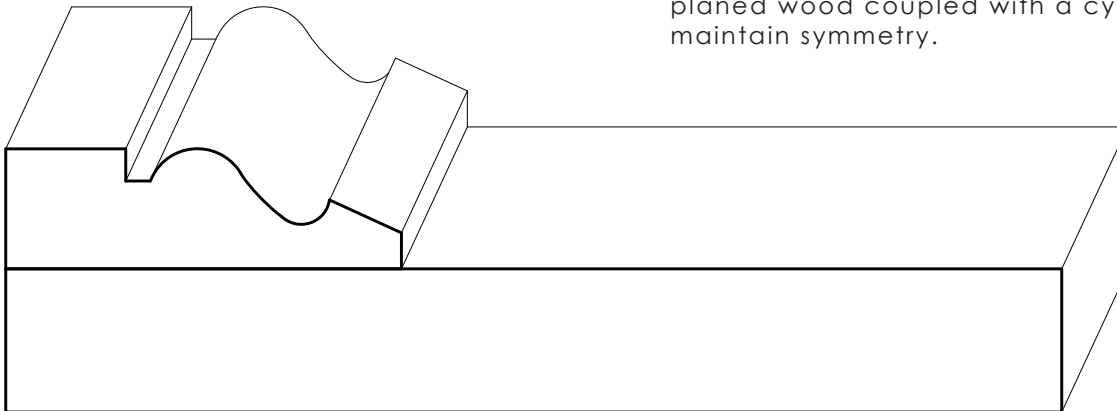


Greek Revival Casing #2

5499 [5/8 x 1-5/8]

S4S [3/4 x 7-1/4]

Less ornate styles of door and window trim include planed wood coupled with a cyma recta or reversa to maintain symmetry.
